TRANSBAY DEMOLITION UPDATE: STREET CLOSURE THIS WEEKEND

Friday, August 13, 2010 – Monday, August 16, 2010

In order to make way for the new Transbay Transit Center at First and Mission streets in downtown San Francisco, the Transbay Joint Powers Authority (TJPA) must demolish the existing bus ramps and Transbay Terminal facility.

We want to remind our neighbors that the first segment of demolition will begin with the removal of the bus ramp over Howard Street (near the Temporary Terminal site) this weekend. Due to the demolition, Howard Street, between Beale and Main Streets, will be closed tonight at 10:00 pm until 5:00 am on Monday, August 16, 2010.

Please note: drivers who use the parking lot at 201 Mission Street (off Howard Street), will be flagged into and out of the parking lot during this time.
