ONE WEEK LOOK AHEAD: Transbay Demolition Activities

Friday, September 3, 2010 – Monday, September 13, 2010

THIS WEEK AT TRANSBAY...

WEEKDAY LANE CLOSURE: A lane on Beale Street (between Howard and Mission Streets) will close due to demolition prep work beneath the overpass. Also, please anticipate a possible partial lane closure eastbound on Howard Street (between Main and Beale Streets) in order to facilitate shoring, excavation and the removal of a column foundation.

HOURS OF WORK: Demolition will continue throughout the week between the hours of 6:00 AM and 3:00 PM. On Saturday September 11, 2010 and Sunday, September 12, 2010, work hours will be between 6:00 AM and 11:00 PM.

SIDEWALK CLOSURE: The sidewalk on the south side of Howard (adjacent to the Temporary Terminal), between Main and Beale Streets, will be closed from September 1, 2010 until September 24, 2010 due to the demolition of the columns and footings. Flaggers will be on-site during work hours. This work may require a partial closure of a traffic lane as described above.

COMMUNITY MEETINGS: We hope that you will join us for our monthly demolition meetings on Wednesday, September 8, 2010 at 12:00 noon and 6:00 PM. The meetings will be held at the TJPA offices at 201 Mission Street in Suite 2100.

ANTICIPATED WEEKEND WORK: No work is scheduled for Labor Day weekend. There will be work the following weekend, beginning on Saturday, September 11, 2010 that will result in the closure of Beale Street (between Howard and Mission Streets). Demolition work will take place between the hours of 6:00 AM and 11:00 PM, on Saturday, September 11, 2010 and Sunday, September 12, 2010. This weekend work is required to remove structures within the street closure period.
