The following question was received related to the above-referenced RFP:

1. *Under Attachment 1 point A it states “(TJPA) will not reimburse the Consultant for the costs of business travel”. In order for companies which are not based within the immediate vicinity of the facility to participate, and in order to bring varied expertise to bear to best support TJPA it is requested that reasonable ODCs are allowable in order to make it reasonably possible for non San Francisco based specialist organizations to offer a competitive proposal. The Attachment 1 Point A provision significantly limits the field and favors only local businesses for what is a specialist and critical support area.*

TJPA will allow reasonable ODCs to cover the costs of business travel. Travel will only be reimbursable if it follows the TJPA Travel Policy for Consultants & Subconsultants, available on the TJPA website at [www.transbaycenter.org](http://www.transbaycenter.org) > TJPA > Doing Business with the TJPA. Travel and other ODCs must be itemized in the fee proposal, and in no case shall more than \$100,000 be paid for this work, including all ODCs.
