Webcor/Obayashi Joint Venture seeks responses to Request for Design Proposal (RFDP) from Trade Subcontractors interested in submitting proposals for the TG08.1 Glazing Design-Build Package on the contract for the Transbay Transit Center (TTC) Project located in San Francisco, California.

The proposers must be prequalified for TG08.1 package through the Request for Qualification (RFQ) process. Proposers which are not prequalified may submit their RFQ submission to Webcor/Obayashi Joint Venture no later than **2:00 PM on November 29, 2010**. Proposals from unqualified proposer will be returned to the respective proposer unopened.

Trade Subcontractors shall possess a valid and current California Contractor's license for the work for which it intends to submit a proposal with the appropriate classifications required and must provide proof of ability to obtain corporate surety (100% payment & performance) bonds and insurance in order to be eligible for the submitting Proposal.

RFDP packages, except the drawings and specifications, will be available for download from the TJPA website (<http://transbaycenter.org/tjpa/doing-business-with-the-tjpa/current-contract-opportunities>). Information regarding how to obtain the drawings and specifications will be posted on the TJPA website.

A pre-proposal conference for Trade Subcontractors interested in submitting proposals will be held on **November 18, 2010**, at **1:00 PM** in the **TJPA offices at 201 Mission Street, Suite 2100, San Francisco, California 94105**. The pre-proposal conference is mandatory for Proposers. It is optional for subcontractors to Proposers.

Each Trade Subcontractor shall submit sealed proposals to the TJPA offices at 201 Mission Street, Suite 2100, San Francisco, CA, 94105 by **2:00 PM Pacific time on December 10, 2010**. No proposals will be accepted after the proposal due date and time.

Webcor/Obayashi Joint Venture reserves the right to reject any or all responses to the RFDP and to waive technical errors in any response received.

The Specifications include liquidated damages. Contract will be on a Lump Sum basis. Progressive payments will be made.

Trade Subcontractors will be required to meet the Transbay Joint Powers Authority's (TJPA's) Small Business Enterprise (SBE) and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise participation requirements. Participation requirements will be defined in the IFB documents.

In accordance with San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 6, no proposal is accepted and no contract in excess of \$100,000 is awarded by the TJPA until the TJPA Board of Directors approves the award. All contract awards are subject to certification by the TJPA Finance Coordinator as to the availability of funds.

This scope of work is estimated to be in excess of \$45,000,000.

Minimum wage rates for this Project must comply with the current General Prevailing Wage as determined by the State Department of Industrial Relations. Minimum wage rates other than those applicable to General Prevailing Wage must comply with San Francisco Administrative Code, Chapter 12P, Minimum Compensation Ordinance.
